



# ST. CLAIR SURF LIFESAVING CLUB

## Surf Sports Equipment Allocation Policy

### 1. Background to Policy

As a competitive Surf Lifesaving club, St Clair Surf Life Saving Club holds as assets a number of Paddle Boards and Surf Ski's.

This equipment is used by club members' primarily in competition and in training in preparation for competition.

This policy is designed to provide guidelines to the membership as to how this equipment is allocated to club members.

### 2. Guidelines to Policy

The St Clair S.L.S.C. Executive Committee or directed representatives have the right to:

- Manage the allocation of club owned equipment.
- Set standards of achievement to qualify for that equipment.

### 3. Deciding Factors for Allocation

- Consideration to commitment and club contributions i.e. patrols, unpaid coaching,
- Dedication to training,
- Selection into Regional and National Teams,
- New Zealand titles or placing at New Zealand Nationals from previous season,
- High achievement at New Zealand Nationals from previous season,
- Regional titles from previous season,
- Factors limiting the use of current club equipment. i.e. size,
- Current season results may see the allocation of equipment should any become available.



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### 4. Conditions of Allocation

Any individual allocated club owned equipment will be subject to the following conditions:

- Members are to be fully financial and competing members of the St Clair S.L.S.C.
- Members are required to pay a maintenance fee for each piece of equipment they are allocated to use, ensuring any damage to that equipment whilst it is allocated to them is reported to the St Clair S.L.S.C. Executive Committee or directed representatives.
- All members allocated club equipment will be liable for repair or replacement costs of any equipment damaged as a result of personal negligence as determined by the St Clair S.L.S.C. Executive Committee.
- Require recipients of club-funded equipment to carry out normal patrol duties /responsibilities in accordance with the clubs minimum patrol policy. (Including the completion of annual life guard refresher).
- Failure to fulfil the conditions/factors listed above may result in the re-allocation of Club equipment.
- At all times any equipment remains the property of the St Clair S.L.S.C.
- All allocation of club equipment is at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
