Other Information:

- 200m badge needs to be worn for all water events.
- Due to the large numbers, Certificates will be given to top three place getters for each individual event. (Templates of Certificates for team events will be emailed to Clubs for them to print out.)
- **Trophies will be given out to overall winners of Otago champs**
- **Overall points for male and female U8,U10,U12,U14, from all interclubs and Otago Champs and hence place getters will be given at Otago Surf prize giving.**
- Most promising junior (U10-U8 and U12-U14) trophy is awarded to the male and female who achieves the most points at Otago Champs in their individual age group, if you compete up an age these points do not count towards your individual points, they will only count towards club points.

Point Allocation:

Individual Events: 1st place – 3 points; 2nd place – 2 points; 3rd place – 1 point

Team Events: 1st place – 5 points; 2nd place – 3 points; 3rd place – 1 point
